By the end of the school year, SJNA upper school students must attend one Fine Arts event to fulfill this requirement and may be fulfilled by attending an event in any of the following areas:

Please note that Fine Arts events attended as a class during the school day does not count towards this requirement.

After attending the fine arts experience, your student must submit an official program or ticket stub, along with a 1-page summary of the event. The summary should include a paragraph with the event title, location, date, and event description. The summary should also include answers to the following questions:

- (1) What was enjoyable about the Fine Arts event?
- (2) Would you consider participating in this art form?
- (3) What would you most like to remember about this event?
- (4) Would you recommend the event to others? Why or why not?

The summary should be typed (double spaced, 1" margins, 12-point *Times New Roman* font). Be sure to use paragraph form, correct sentence structure, and proper punctuation. It should be one page in length and is due to me, along with the program or ticket stub, no later than Friday, May 10, 2024.
